Project: Training for Local Authorities in Scotland

On 14 July 2000 the Part IIA Contaminated Land regime of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 was implemented in Scotland. As a result LQM was commissioned by the National Society for Clean Air (NSCA) to provide training for Scottish Local Authorities on issues relating to the new regime.

A working group consisting of members from a number of bodies involved in the contaminated land arena; including the Scottish Executive, NSCA, Convention Of Scottish Local Authorities (COSLA) and Scottish Environment Protection Agency (SEPA) were involved in developing the content and structure of the training programme with LQM.

In October/November 2000 LQM delivered a series of successful two day workshops on Inspection Strategies at three venues in Scotland. Delegates from thirty one of the thirty two Local Authorities in Scotland participated in the training.

The next round of training, comprising of series of two day workshops on risk assessment will be undertaken in Spring 2001.
